
Services Typically Provided by a Design Office



Design Services Checklist

The following list is extensive (but not exhaustive); however all the services are rarely required together for a single project. Some design offices will not be able to supply all of these services. If you read this and still do not know for sure what you require, please feel free to contact us and we will help you to decide what you need. (Check the website for contact details.)

- 1. Professional Indemnity Insurance (All professional designers must have this cover.)
- 2. Professional Help & Advice at all stages of the construction project
- 3. Certificates for each phase of building works, as required by your Mortgage Lenders / Solicitors
- 4. Preliminary Site Inspection & Analysis of planning policy requirements; for Planning Applications
- 5. Consultations & Meetings at your site, home or office
- 6. Detailed Site Surveys
- 7. Site Analysis for Renewable Energy Installations and passive house design requirements
- 8. Survey of Site Levels and contours
- 9. Tree Survey & Report (position, species, condition, dimensions, actions required, etc.)
- 10. Preliminary Conceptual Design to help you make decisions for a final design solution
- 11. Multiple or Repeat Preliminary Designs
- 12. Site Concept & Analysis Statement in support of the planning application
- 13. License to reproduce Ordnance Survey maps (a crown copyright requirement)
- 14. Standard Working Drawings as a minimum these will include:
 - ✓ Floor Plans
 - ✓ Drainage Layout
 - ✓ All Elevations
 - ✓ Sectional views through buildings
 - ✓ Construction Details
 - ✓ Detailed notes and specifications
 - ✓ Site Plan
 - ✓ Location Map
- 15. Additional Drawings & Specifications these can include:
 - ✓ Structural Engineering Design Drawings
 - ✓ Landscape Design / Detailed Planting Schedules
 - ✓ Deed maps / Transfer maps
 - ✓ Detailed Tree Planting Schedule
 - ✓ Sectional & Contoured Site Drawings
 - ✓ Roof Configuration Plans
 - ✓ Ceiling Plans
 - ✓ Electrical & Services Layouts



- ✓ Foundation Plans
- ✓ Non-standard foundation design (piles, pads, raft, etc.)
- ✓ Dimensioned Site Plan for Setting-Out
- ✓ Drawings for garage, outbuildings and other structures
- ✓ Retaining wall design
- ✓ Door & Window Schedules
- ✓ Internal Door & Ironmongery Schedule
- 16. Making detailed application to Planning Service.
- 17. Providing such additional information as deemed necessary by the planners
- 18. Making detailed application to Building Control
- 19. SAPs (Standard Assessment Procedure) for thermal efficiency rating of building (UK).
- 20. Amending drawings as required by Building Control.
- 21. Making application to Environmental Health for Effluent Discharge Approval
- 22. Carrying out percolation tests for consent to discharge effluent to an underground stratum
- 23. Making Application to Rivers Agency for Surface Water Discharge to a Waterway
- 24. Application for a new Electricity Supply
- 25. Application for Making a New Entrance to a Public Road
- 26. Printing and copying all application documents,
- 27. Paper copies of drawings for obtaining builders' prices
- 28. Electronic copies of drawings for obtaining suppliers prices
- 29. Laminated copies of drawings for the builder on site
- 30. Structural Engineer's Calculations & Design Drawings
- 31. Structural Surveys & Reports for Existing Buildings
- 32. Environmental Impact Assessment. This can include:
 - ✓ Acoustic Survey & Report
 - ✓ Odour Assessment
 - ✓ Visual Impact Assessment & Report
 - ✓ Flora / Fauna survey & report on potential impact on protected / endangered species
 - ✓ Pollution Assessment (brownfield sites, bogs, etc.)
 - ✓ Assessment for Hazardous Materials or Processes
 - ✓ Flood Risk Assessments
- 33. Checking of Timber Frame manufacturers' drawings to protect the integrity of the original design
- 34. Written Specifications
- 35. Tender Documents
- 36. Contract Documents
- 37. Bills of Quantities / Materials Lists
- 38. Site Inspection Service
- 39. Liaison with Contractors / Contract Management
- 40. Supervision & Project Management
